Winners in 2009 and short-listed in 2008 - the AIM Achievement in Sustainability award

Modern Water was named the winner of the Achievement in Sustainability award at the 2009 AIM Awards. The company was recognised by the voting panel for its efforts in economic, environmental and social sustainability. It is the second successive year that Modern Water has been nominated at the event, which is organised by the London Stock Exchange.

Modern Water was established to help address the global problems of fresh water availability and the treatment and disposal of wastewater through the investment and deployment of leading technologies. Leadership and innovation were two of the attributes sought by the AIM Awards' voting panel.

The Achievement in Sustainability award recognises accomplishments in one or more of the three key areas of economic, environmental and social sustainability. The diversity of AIM companies and the spectrum of sustainability issues they face means that the winner's achievements may relate to improvements in products or services, management of supply chain, reducing resource usage or carbon footprint, or other operational aspects. The Voting Panel looks for leadership, innovation and lasting commitment to sustainability.
